

Ross Stores Appoints Michael Hamilton Senior Vice President, Stores

The off-price retailer operates 349 stores in 17 states, offering firstquality, in season, branded apparel, accessories and footwear for the entire family as well as gift items and linens for the home all at everyday savings of 20% to 60% less than regular department and specialty store prices.
